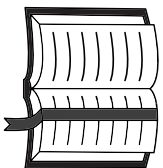
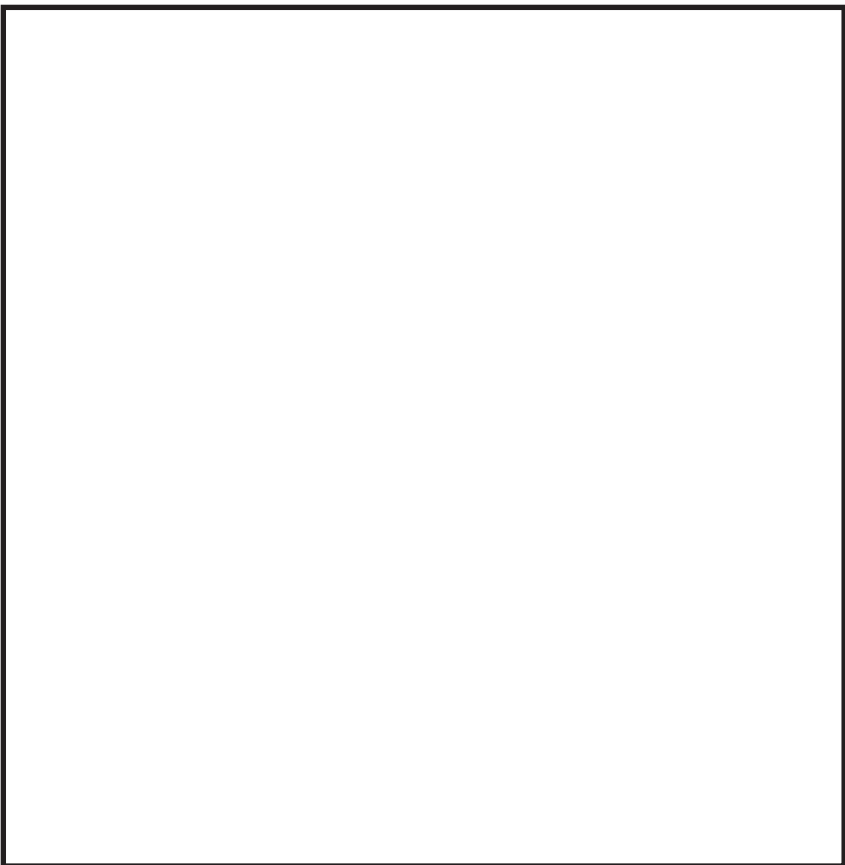




DRAW IT

Paul encourages us in 1 Timothy to pray for all people. Draw the people that you want to pray for right now. It might be someone who is a friend, or a family member, or someone else.

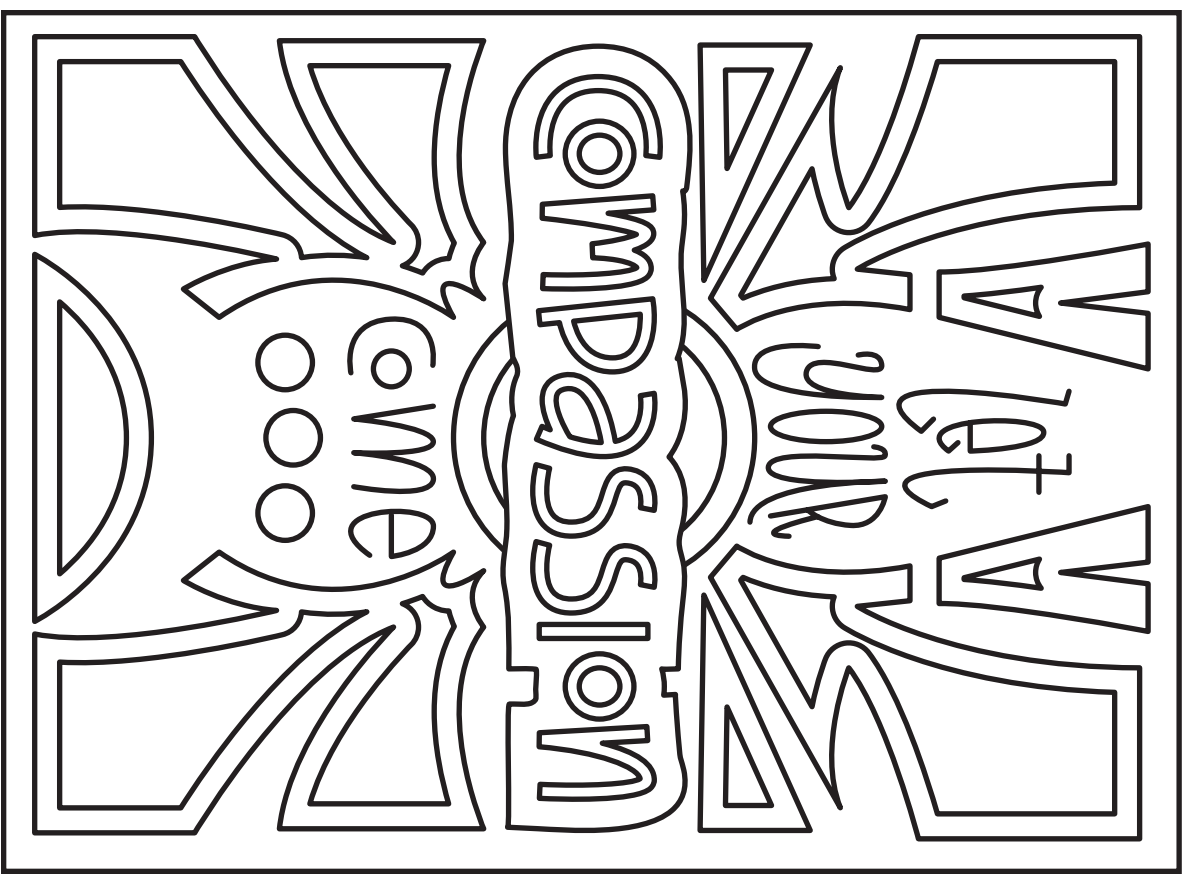

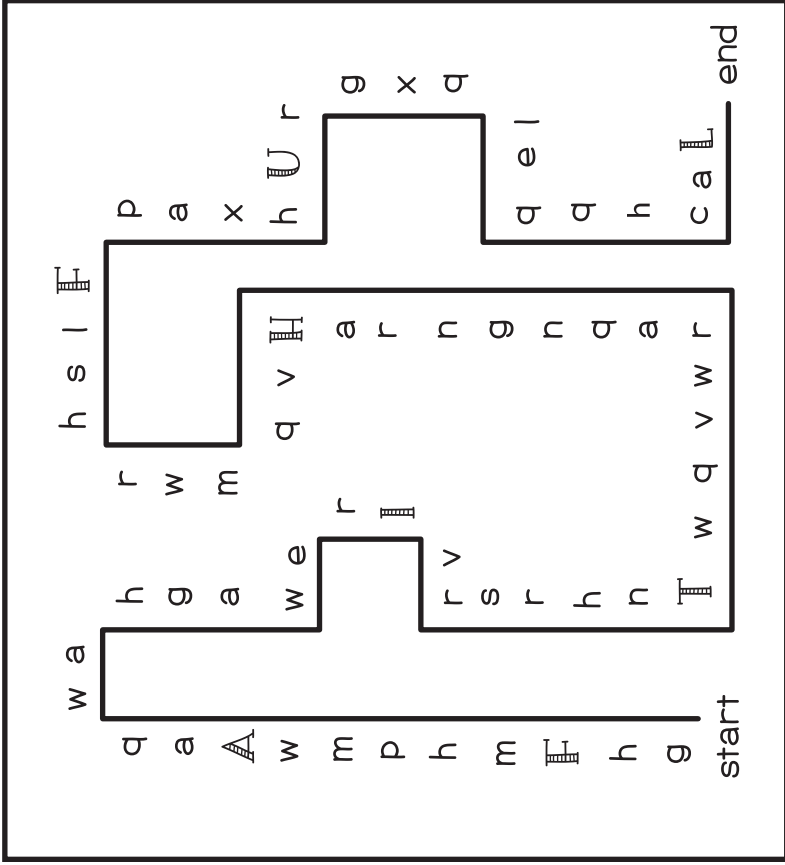
